## Pre-Tow Checklist: Setting Up for a Safe Journey

Before you tow your boat, thorough preparation is critical. This section covers the essential checks for your trailer, tow vehicle, and boat to ensure a safe and smooth trip.

1. Trailer Lights:

Check brake lights, turn signals, tail lights, and side markers. Upgrade to LED lights, apply dielectric grease, and clean connectors.

2. Trailer Brakes:

Check brake fluid levels, seals, and brake pad wear. Follow manual for adjustments.

#### 3. Tires:

Check pressure (cold), tread depth, sidewalls, and use ST trailer tires.

### Example Sizes:

- ST205/75R14 (50-65 PSI)
- ST225/75R15 (65-80 PSI)
- ST235/80R16 (80-90 PSI)

#### 4. Wheel Bearings:

Lubricate, check for noise/play, inspect seals, and test hub temperature.

#### 5. Hitch and Coupler:

Ensure correct hitch ball size, secure coupler, trailer is level, safety chains are crossed and connected, and breakaway cable is attached.

6. Boat Security:

Tighten bow strap, attach transom tie-downs, stow loose gear, secure boat cover.

7. Outboard or Sterndrive:

Raise to avoid pavement contact, use a transom saver.

8. Trailer Tongue Jack:

Retract and secure in travel position.

9. Tow Vehicle Mirrors:

Adjust for full trailer visibility.

10. Legal Compliance:

Confirm trailer brakes, permits for wide loads, and current registration. Carry BoatUS membership for roadside help.

## Pre-Launch Checklist: Preparing to Hit the Water

At the ramp, complete the following:

- 1. Drain Plug: Install and check.
- 2. Trailer Lights: Disconnect and secure plugs.
- 3. Battery Switch: Turn on.
- 4. Outboard/Sterndrive: Lower and remove brackets.
- 5. Tie-Downs: Remove all but bow strap.
- 6. Dock Lines/Fenders: Attach before launch.
- 7. Equipment Check:

Life jackets, extinguisher, bilge pump, radio, nav lights.

8. Passenger Briefing: Emergency procedures and safety.

Raise antennas/Bimini. Run blower or prime fuel bulb.

## Retrieval and Trailering Home: Securing for the Return Trip

After boating, follow these steps:

1. Prepare the Boat:

Raise engine, lower antennas/Bimini, remove drain plug.

2. Load the Boat:

Back trailer, align boat, attach bow strap and chain, check hull position.

3. Secure the Boat:

Reattach straps, install engine bracket, stow gear/cover.

4. Trailer Checks:

Reconnect lights, inspect tires/bearings/hitch, tighten lug nuts.

5. Clean and Maintain:

Rinse boat/trailer, flush engine, remove plant material.
